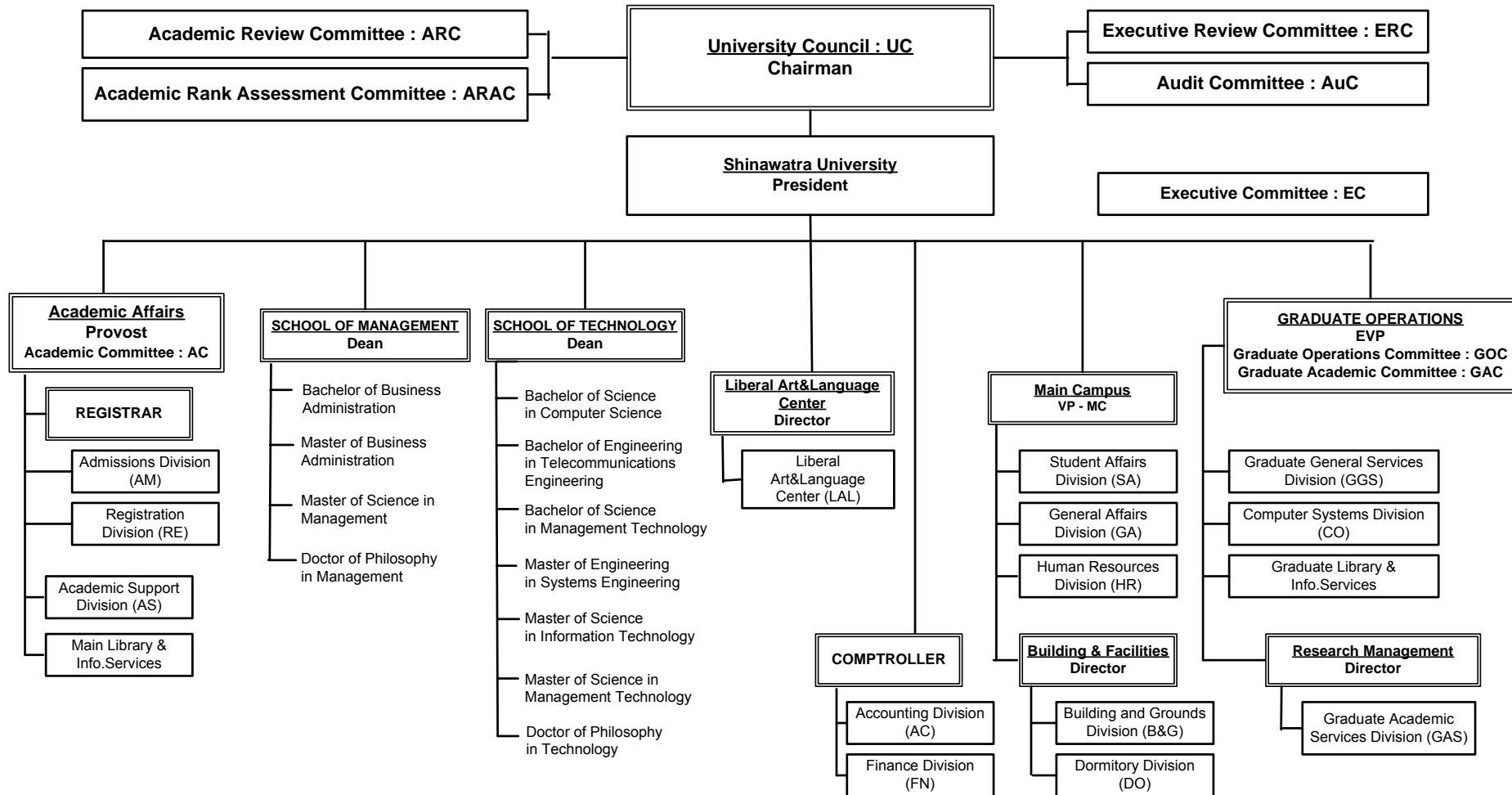
Missions

Brief Historical Development

- 1996** The idea of establishing a private university to support development in Thailand and in the region was initiated by Dr Thaksin Shinawatra and associates.
- 1999** The Ministry of University Affairs granted a license for setting up Shinawatra University (SIU).
- 2000** The first meeting of Shinawatra University Council (SIUC) was held on May 19.
- 2001** Master's degree program in Business Administration and Bachelor's degree programs in Built Environment, Business Administration and Computer Science were approved by SIUC.
- 2002** Teaching at SIU first commenced in September. Bachelor's degree programs in Built Environment, Computer Science, Business Administration and a Master's degree program in Business Administration were offered.
- 2004**
- Floors 15&16 of Shinawatra Tower III Building were approved by SIUC for graduate operation of SIU.
 - Master's degree programs in Information Technology, Management Technology, Systems Engineering and in Management were approved by SIUC
 - First graduation ceremony was held for Master's of Business Administration graduates.
- 2005** Bachelor's degree programs in Architectural Technology and Management Technology and Doctor of Philosophy in Technology and in Management were approved by SIUC.

- SIUC approved two additional specialized options namely Architectural Technology of BSc (Management Technology) and Engineering Systems Management of MSc (Management Technology) respectively
 - Graduation ceremony was held for the first batches of Bachelor's of Business Administration, Computer Science, Telecommunications Engineering, and Master's of Science in Information and Management Technology graduates.
- 2007** The first batch of Master of Engineering in Systems Engineering and Bachelor of Science in Architectural Technology graduated.

Facilities

Computer

Recognizing information technology as a cutting edge tool for education, research and management, good computing and computer networking facilities are essential for high-quality management and study environment.

Shinawatra University Main Campus is well equipped with a leading information technology infrastructure. The campus has high speed networks for internal and Internet communications. Students and faculty members have access to the networks from fixed work stations or by wireless connection from anywhere in the campus.

Shinawatra University Graduate Building at Shinawatra Tower III is also well equipped with up-to-date computing and computer networking equipments. On 15th and 16th floors are hot spots with wireless connection at 64 Mbps (802.11g) Students with wi-fi enabled devices, notebooks or PDAs, can access the internet any where and at time in the Graduate Building.



The Graduate Building is connected to the Main Campus in Pathumthani with a fiber optic link at 1 Gbps and 128 Kbps ISDN backup link. The university's Internet connection, our gate way to the world, is at a speed of 3 Mbps. Every student is provided with an Internet and e-mail account with a storage capacity of 250 MB.

Dormitories

Air-conditioned dormitories are available on the Main Campus at Pathumthani during the regular semesters and summer sessions. SIU provides separate facilities for men and women.

Computer network connections, a telephone line, a refrigerator and a hot/cold water system are available in each room. On each floor, students have access to a common room with TV.

Each resident will be given 3 keys; room, desk and wardrobe. The students will be provided with a smart card, which gives them access to the dormitory. All undergraduate students are encouraged to stay on campus at least for the first year.



Library

The Shinawatra University Library has two branches, one located at the main campus in Pathumthani and the other at the Graduate Building in Bangkok. The Library of Congress Classification System is used for organizing the library's collection. Self check-out station are situated at both locations. The library also utilizes an automated library system and computer facilities to support user wishing to access the library and information resources from anywhere and at any time.

The Undergraduate library at the main campus has a total floor area of 800 square meters with a seating capacity of 150, and houses over 13,000 of the most current books and periodicals from around the world. The Graduate library at the Graduate Building has a total floor area of 255square meters with a seating capacity of 74, and house over 4,000 of the most current and seminal works in management, technology and related topics, in addition to hardcopies of both international and national journal including 39 top business, management, technology and computer journals.

Online database services enable users to access online journals and other publications, all of which consist of more than 4,200 journals. Document delivery service offers an additional convenience for user – shuttle buses run twice daily to transport requested item between the two libraries. Additionally, interlibrary loan services, which are in agreement with library cooperation, facilities further research and studies of SIU students and faculty members. Such services are provided among many leading university libraries in Thailand.

Generally, the on-site libraries are open 13 hours a day, 6 day a week. The online catalog and references databases are accessible 24 hours a day on the Internet at the website <http://library.shinawatra.ac.th>.
